Glossary: complicated words in the story

Booming: Making a loud, deep sound

Playlist: A list of songs or music that are played in a particular order

Charades: A game in which players act out a word or phrase without speaking, and others guess what it is

Imitate: To copy someone's actions or behavior

Honking: Making a loud noise like a car horn

Squeaking: Making a high-pitched sound like a mouse

Chirping: Making a series of high-pitched sounds like a bird

Groaning: Making a deep, low sound like someone in pain

Joke-off: A competition where participants take turns telling jokes to see who can make people laugh the most

Puzzled: Confused or unsure

Bursting: Suddenly and forcefully coming out with a sound or action

Harmony: A state of peaceful and friendly coexistence
